

Dr. Jean A. Lukesh

Dr. Lukesh is a Nebraska author and 15-time National/International Book Award-Winner who will be discussing her recently published book, *Secret Brother: the Story of Solon Borglum, "Sculptor of the Prairie."*

Borglum. That name generally brings to mind the monumental faces of American Presidents carved into South Dakota's Mount Rushmore by Gutzon Borglum. But did you know that the sculpting of Mount Rushmore was actually inspired by Gutzon's secret brother Solon who lived on a ranch in pioneer Hall County, Nebraska, and who carved the faces and figures of Plains Indians into the hills there, long before Mount Rushmore?
