To: All who may submit a proposal for a used ambulance for the City Of Grand Island

RE: Clarification of the Request for Proposal

The proposal as written contains the phrase, "Proposals shall remain firm for a period of thirty (30) days after the proposal date." This language is not intended to require all proposals to remain available exclusively to the City Of Grand Island for 30 days. It is intended to prevent a proposed price from increasing for a period of thirty days after the proposals are submitted. The city understands that we are not the only potential purchaser of your product and don't expect you to hold your product for us exclusively. If another buyer purchases your product within the 30 days after the proposal and the product is no longer available, this will not violate the terms of the RFP. We would expect that if we negotiate a tentative agreement to purchase your product, you will not sell it to another purchaser until our elected body has had a chance to approve or deny the tentative agreement. Typically, this time period would not be longer than 14 days.
