A Call to Serve

The Hall County Citizen Corps Council is calling for volunteers to establish a new county-wide Community Emergency Response Team.

The CERT Program educates people about disaster preparedness and trains them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, and disaster medical operations.
