MINIMUM BID SPECIFICATIONS

FOAMING ROOT CONTROL CHEMICAL

The chemical must be compatible to work with the Foaming equipment that the city already has. The current foaming machine is a Skid Mount Vaporooter Rootfoamer. The City will consider any chemical that meets or exceeds required minimum specifications as stated herein or any approved equal chemical. The City of Grand Island reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive any technicalities.

Note: Chemical must be produced in the current year.

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 The purpose of this document is to specify a product to control tree roots in sanitary sewers.
 - Chemicals designed to be applied by soaking, spraying, dusting, pouring down the manholes, or other methods of application will not be considered.
- 1.2 The active ingredients in the chemical root control agent shall be Metam Sodium and Dichlobenil.
 - Only products that contain both of these active ingredients specifically labeled for use in sanitary sewers to control tree roots will be considered.

2. COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAWS

- 2.1 In accordance with federal and state law, only products which are currently registered with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and with the Nebraska Department of Agriculture will be considered.
- 2.2 Bidders must be licensed as pesticide dealers with Nebraska Department of Agriculture (DOA) before filling any orders placed for materials by the City, as required by law.
- 2.3 All packing, and shipping procedures must comply with federal and state Department of Transportation (DOT) laws and regulations.

3. TYPE AND COMPOSITION OF THE CHEMICAL ROOT CONTROL AGENT

- 3.1 The product shall be composed of these components:
 - Metam Sodium: The Metam Sodium shall be packaged and labeled separate from other component ingredients and formulated as water soluble liquid containing a minimum of 32.7% AI (active ingredient) by weight.
 - <u>Dichlobenil:</u> The dichiobenil shall be formulated as minimum 50W wettable clay powder.
 - A 5 gallon unit of chemical root control product must contain 30 ounces of 50W dichlobenil 15 ounces of active Dichlobenil herbicide, and 15 ounces of wettable clay.
- 3.2 <u>Foaming Agent:</u> The foaming agent, when mixed as a 1% aqueous solution and applied though standard foam application equipment, shall produce a small bubble, dense foam capable of sustaining its shape and remaining on treated roots for a period of one hour.

4. PACKAGING

- 4.1 Containers must meet all DOT and OSHA requirements for the product supplied.
- 4.2 All pesticide containers shall be pelletized and shrunk wrapped.
- 4.3 To ensure product stability, freshness and shelf life, all three product components must be packaged in separate containers.
 - In particular, the Metam Sodium must not be formulated or mixed with the foaming surfactant.
- To minimize the potential for drift, the Dichlobenil powder will be packaged in a separate container for easy mixing.
 - Plastic bags that must be cut or shaken, to empty product are not acceptable.

5. EQUIPMENT COMPATIBILTY

5.1 Bidders must warrant that the materials bid herein are compatible for use with the City's Skid Mount Vaporooter Rootfoamer Machine, the current chemical root control equipment used.

6. WARRANTY

- 6.1 The Bidder shall warranty the chemical products as follows:
 - The Bidder <u>warranty</u>'s the products shelf life for two years from the date of delivery.
 - Any chemical product that is determined by the City to be defective in foam quality and/or chemical composition, within this 2 year period, will be returned to the Bidder at their expense, for a full refund.

7. REQUIRMENTS CONTRACT

- 7.1 The city is not obligated to any minimum or maximum quantities under the contract.
