Payment

Any equipment that does not meet the City's requirements will be returned at vendor's expense for correction. Title, manufacturer's use tax form, odometer form and any specified data, diagrams and manuals must be received prior to approval of invoice. The invoice will be paid at the next regularly scheduled Council meeting occuring after the approval of invoice; the City Council typically meets the second and fourth Monday of each month. Invoices must be received well in advance of the Council date to allow evaluation and processing time.

Gratuities and Kickbacks

City Code states that it is unethical for any person to offer, give or agree to give any City employee or former City employee, or for any City employee or former City employee to solicit, demand, accept, or agree to accept from another person, a gratuity or an offer of employment in connection with any decision, approval, disapproval, recommendation, or preparation of any part of a program requirement or a purchase request, influencing the content of any specification or procurement standard, rendering of advice, investigation, auditing, or in any other advisory capacity in any proceeding or application, request for ruling, determination, claim or controversy, or other particular matter, pertaining to any program requirement or a contract or subcontract, or to any solicitation or proposal therefore. It shall be unethical for any payment, gratuity, or offer of employment to be made by or on behalf of a subcontractor under a contract to the prime contractor or higher tier subcontractor or any person associated therewith, as an inducement for the award of a subcontract or order.

Fiscal Year Budget -

The City of Grand Island, Nebraska operates on a fiscal year beginning October 1st and ending on the following September 30th. It is understood and agreed that any portion of this agreement which will be performed in a future fiscal year is contingent upon the City Council adopting budget statements and appropriations sufficient to fund such performance.

Bid Evaluation and Award -

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after bid due date. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive technicalities and to accept the bid considered by the purchaser to be in the City's best interest. Bids will be evaluated by the purchaser based on conformity to specifications, demonstration, delivery, price, quality, economy of operation, experience of the manufacturer, availability of parts and service for repair and maintenance, and adaptability of the particular equipment for the specific use intended.

MINIMUM BID SPECIFICATIONS

One (1) 28,000 Pound Four-Wheel Drive Front End Loader

The unit described shall be new, current year manufacture, four-wheel drive loader that is the manufacturer's latest design and production, complete, serviced, ready for work including all standard equipment and any optional equipment as deemed necessary by the City of Grand Island. The City will consider any unit that meets or exceeds required minimum specifications as stated herein or any approved equal unit. The City of Grand Island reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive any technicalities.

NOTE: The unit may be utilized for other applications in addition to Street and Transportation operations. The unit shall be equipped with a quick coupler system described in Section 8 of these specifications and be capable of handling various attachments including City owned snow blowers.

REQUIRED MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS:

1. Operating Weight:

28,000 pounds minimum SAE weight exclusive of tire ballast; sufficient counter weights required as needed to balance bucket size and attachments.

2. Engine:

145 minimum SAE net horsepower, 550 lb-ft minimum torque at 1400 rpm, turbocharged diesel engine; bidder shall state engine design, wet sleeve liner or solid block, and provide fuel consumption/ performance chart with bid proposal.

3. Transmission:

Automatic type with full power shift with torque converter. Minimum three forward and three reverse speeds.

4. Steering:

Fully hydraulic with 2 double acting hydraulic cylinders.

Minimum 40 degree articulation each way.

Maximum machine turning radius (curb to curb) of not greater than 20 feet

5. Drive Axles:

Planetary gear drive to each axle.

Limited slip or foot operated, hydraulically actuated differential lock/unlock engageable on-the-go under full power in any gear required on one axle, rear axle preferred. No-Spin differential is not acceptable.

6. Brakes:

Service brakes shall be self adjusting, heavy duty. Bidder shall state brake system type and specifications.

Parking/secondary brake shall be independent of service brakes and shall be equipped with a warning light and/or buzzer and be of sufficient design to hold the weight of the machine on a moderate slope.

7. Tires:

The unit shall be equipped with 20.5 R 25 Michelin XHA tires (or equal) front and rear.

8. Loader:

The loader shall be equipped minimum (2.75 cy) two and three-quarter heaped capacity general purpose bucket. The bucket shall be complete with 4-piece bolt-on reversible, replaceable cutting edges. The loader shall have automatic return-to-dig, bucket self-leveling, and boom height control. The loader shall be equipped with hydraulically actuated male and female quick coupling system. The coupler system shall be a Balderson BQ936, Part No. 6340C3. Minimum break-out force of 28,500 pounds is required. An automatic ride control system shall be provided.

9. Hydraulic System:

The hydraulic system shall have an independent engine driven pump, replaceable filter, hydraulic oil sight gauge, and be the most efficient system available to ensure best machine performance.

The hydraulic system shall be a three (3) spool valve configuration, three (3) lever control. Third valve function shall be to operate additional mounted equipment such as angle blade, grapple fork, etc. Third valve shall be plumbed to quick coupler on loader boom and hose ends capped.

10. Cooling System:

A heavy duty pressurized liquid cooling system shall be required. Radiators shall have 6 fins/inch and filled with manufacturer's approved low silicate anti-freeze solution that provides protection to at least –40 degrees F. Transmission and hydraulic oil coolers shall be provided if available from the manufacturer.

11. Electrical:

Batteries shall be heavy duty minimum maintenance or maintenance free with a minimum 650 CCA each. Alternator shall be a minimum 50 amps or larger if available. The unit shall have a minimum of four front and two rear work lights, two combination stop/tail lights, and a lighted instrument panel. The unit shall be radio frequency shielded and compatible with 12 volt two way radio equipment including voltage reduction to 12 volts if required (minimum 20 amp capacity).

12. Cab:

The unit shall have a fully enclosed steel sound-suppressed cab that provides rollover protection in accordance with SAE J394, SAE 1040C, and ISO 3471. Integral ROPS desired if available. The cab shall include a heater, defroster, factory installed air conditioning, front and rear windshield wiper/washers if available, dome light, floor mat, tinted safety glass, and interior and exterior rear view mirrors. The operator's seat shall be fabric deluxe air suspension type from manufacturer. Seat belt shall be required.

13. Cab Instrumentation:

Cab instrumentation shall have dash mounted gauges and/or monitoring system to include transmission temperature, engine coolant temperature, engine oil pressure, parking brake engagement, hydraulic filter restriction, fuel, alternator, and electric hour meter. Engine coolant, engine oil pressure, and brake pressure shall include audible and visual warning.

14. Additional Equipment:

The unit shall be equipped with all standard equipment and shall include key ignition switch, foot throttle, horn, cold weather starting aid, engine block heater, air intake pre-cleaner, dry type air cleaner with safety element and restriction indicator, muffler, hinged and lockable engine compartment, front and rear fenders, reverse warning alarm, primary and secondary engine fuel filters, ride control system, mounting steps and safety hand holds, vandal protection, overhead strobe warning light visible up to 500 yards, calibrated air restriction indicator, and AM-FM radio.

15. Manuals:

The following manuals shall be provided:

- A. Two (2) complete Operator's manuals
- B. One (1) complete Service manuals including bulletins
- C. One (1) complete Equipment Parts manual
- D. One (1) complete Engine Parts manual
- E. Operator's, Service, and Parts manuals for supplementary or optional or components

16. Warranty:

Manufacturer's warranty against defects in parts and workmanship shall be required. <u>Bidder shall attach a copy of the warranty.</u>

17. Repair Parts and Service Performance:

Since the continuous operation of this machine is of the utmost importance with quick and reliable factory and dealer support a necessity, it will be required that the successful bidder shall enter into the following service agreement with the City of Grand Island which shall remain in effect throughout the City's ownership of this unit.

- A. The bidder warrants that all service and repair will be performed by certified mechanics experienced in the operation and maintenance of such equipment. All repair and service work shall be performed by a factory authorized dealer.
- B. The bidder shall provide manufacturer recommended equipment training related to safety procedures, lubrication schedules, preventative maintenance, and equipment servicing. Scheduling for the training shall be at the City's option.
- C. To every extent possible, warranty repairs and repairs purchased from seller shall be performed at the City's Central Garage Facilities. In the event the repairs are requested from the successful bidder, the bidder shall warranty that the equipment is to be placed back in service within forty-eight (48) hours after the request is made for repairs at the City's Central Garage facility. If certain major repairs require the equipment be taken to the successful bidder's off-site facility, the bidder shall warrant that the equipment shall be placed back in service within seventy-two (72) hours after the request for off-site service is made.
- D. The successful bidder shall have the ability to provide service and repair work if so requested by the City during weekends, holidays and nights.

E. In the event any warranty service and repairs cannot be completed by the successful bidder within the time constraints listed herein, the bidder shall provide to the City, at no cost, suitable replacement equipment or pay the City liquidated damages equal to the normal and customary rental rate for such equipment. The above referenced time requirements shall not apply if any delays beyond those specified are caused by Acts of God, strike, or other reasonable considerations beyond the control of the bidder.

Bidder shall attach his proposed program for parts and service availability for evaluation. Review of bidder's ability to provide prompt and dependable parts and service may be used in determining the lowest qualified bidder.

18. Demonstration:

The vendor or manufacturer of any machine which is seriously considered for award shall at the request of the customer, demonstrate his machine at a mutually agreed time and location and in the presence of authorized customer representatives.
