Sealed proposals will be received at the Community Development Division Office, City Hall, 100 E. First St., P.O. Box 1968, Grand Island, Nebraska, 68802, until **4:00 PM (Local Time)**, on **Friday, March 11, 2011**, for work to be done as described in the proposal documents to include: Georeferenced Airborne Thermal Infrared (TIR) imaging of the City. The City seeks an experienced aerial surveying company with strong geospatial capabilities and a minimum of 5 years experience in providing aerial high quality photography. Proposals will be publicly opened at this time in Conference Room #9 located on 2nd floor of City Hall. Proposals received after specified time will be returned unopened to sender.

The successful proposer will be required to comply with: 1) Section 1606 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 with regard to Davis-Bacon Act prevailing wage requirements for projects in excess of \$2,000 for the construction, alteration, and/or repair of public buildings or public works, 2) Section 1605 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 with regard to Buy American Recovery Act provisions, 3) fair labor standards as required by Nebraska R.R.S. 73-102 and comply with Nebraska R.R.S. 48-657 pertaining to contributions to the Unemployment Compensation Fund of the State of Nebraska, 4) supply ENERGY STAR qualified and Federal Energy Management Program designated products, and 5) additional compliance requirements outlined in the Contract Award Terms.

Each envelope must be clearly marked "Proposal for Georeferenced Airborne Thermal Infrared Imaging." Failure to submit the necessary qualifying information in clearly marked and separate envelopes will result in your proposal not being opened or considered.
