### MINUTES OF CITIZENS ADVISORY REVIEW COMMITTEE September 1, 2022

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Regular Meeting of the Citizens Advisory Review Committee (CARC) of Grand Island, Nebraska was held in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 100 East 1<sup>st</sup> Street on September 1, 2022. Notice of the meeting was given in *The Grand Island Independent* on August 25, 2022.

Chairman Matthew Armstrong called the meeting to order at 12:02 p.m. The following board members were present: Matthew Armstrong, Jack Sheard, Tom O'Neill, Mike Kneale, and Jason Roe. Jason Morledge was absent. City Officials present were City Clerk RaNae Edwards and Finance Director Patrick Brown.

<u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES.</u> Motion by Jack Sheard, second by Tom O'Neill to approve the minutes of the June 30, 2022 meeting. Upon roll call vote, all voted aye. Motion adopted.

GRAND ISLAND AREA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT UPDATE. GIAEDC Executive Director Dave Taylor presented the GIAEDC Update.

LB840 funds invested were \$6,729,100. There were 1,114 jobs created with annual wages of \$36,807,222 at an average wage from 2015-2021 of \$19.88 per hour. There were actually 55.9 more FTE's hired with a wage of \$13.51 over the average wage. Companies were hiring more employees and paying more per hour than the contract required.

The following LB840 Projects were active:

- Zabuni Specialty Coffee Auction 10 new jobs
- Amur Equipment Finance 15 new jobs
- GIX Logistics (2021) 15 new jobs
- Hornady Manufacturing 50 new jobs

Current LB840 Balance was \$1,671,722. The following LB840 commitments were active:

- Amur Equipment Finance \$20,000
- Zabuni Specialty Coffee \$51,666
- GIX Logistics (2021) \$202,334
- Hornady Manufacturing \$398,334
- EDC Operating Funds \$87,000
- City Admin Fee \$22,500

Ending LB840 balance was \$889,988.

Mr. Taylor stated the current LB840 program would expire on September 30, 2023. The renewal of the LB 840 Economic Development Program would go to the General Election on November

8, 2022. The LB840 program had been in existence for 20 years in Grand Island. By continuing this plan it would keep Grand Inland's momentum going, keep and support employers and employees; and help more people to find reasons to call Grand Island home. If LB840 is approved at the General Election the new plan would start on October 1, 2023 and last for 10 years.

Reviewed were several business recruitment projects. Mentioned was Grand Island being in a perfect location for businesses both large and small.

October 27, 2022 was scheduled for "Big Idea Grand Island". Also mentioned was "Call Grand Island Home". Mr. Taylor explained how this program worked and how it was reaching people across the internet.

The next meeting will be held on December 1, 2022 at noon.
