

**CONTRACT AGREEMENT  
TREE REMOVAL CONTRACT 2024-TR-1

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into, by and between

Leetch Tree Service  
hereinafter called the Contractor, and the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, hereinafter called the City

WITNESSETH

THAT, WHEREAS, in accordance with law, the City has caused contract documents to be prepared and an advertisement calling for bids to be published, for construction of Tree Removal 2024-TR-1 and

WHEREAS, the City, in the manner prescribed by law, has publicly opened, examined and canvassed the bids submitted, and has determined the aforesaid Contractor to be the lowest responsive bidder, and has duly awarded to the said Contractor a contract therefore, for the sum or sums named in the Contractor's bid, a copy thereof being attached to and made a part of this contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the compensation to be paid to the Contractor and of the mutual agreements herein contained, the parties have agreed and hereby agree, the City for itself and its successors, and the Contractor for itself, himself, or themselves, and its, his, or their successors, as follows

ARTICLE I. That the Contractor shall (a) furnish all tools, equipment, superintendence, transportation, and other construction materials, services and facilities, (b) furnish, as agent for the City, all materials, supplies and equipment specified and required to be incorporated in and form a permanent part of the completed work, (c) provide and perform all necessary labor, and (d) in a good substantial and workmanlike manner and in accordance with the requirements, stipulations, provisions, and conditions of the contract documents as listed in the attached General Specifications, said documents forming the contract and being as fully a part thereof as if repeated verbatim herein, perform, execute, construct and complete all work included in and covered by the City's official award of this contract to the said Contractor, such award being based on the acceptance by the City of the Contractor's bid.

ARTICLE II. That the City shall pay to the Contractor for the performance of the tree removal embraced in this Contract and the Contractor will accept as full compensation (subject to adjustment as provided by the Contract) covered by and included in the Contract award and designated in the foregoing Article I; payments thereof to be made in cash or its equivalent in the manner provided in the General Specifications

ARTICLE III. It is understood and agreed that time is the essence of the Contract. No work shall commence until the Certificate of Insurance and bonds are approved by the City and the Contract is executed. The
