

**GIAMPO RESOLUTION NO. 2024-3**

**Grand Island Area Metropolitan Planning Organization**

**A Resolution Adopting the Adjusted 2020 Urban Area Boundary Map**

**WHEREAS**, the Grand Island Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (GIAMPO), is designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Grand Island Urbanized Area, by the Governor acting through the Nebraska Department of Transportation in cooperation with locally elected officials of the Grand Island Urbanized Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Census Bureau designated the 2020 Census qualifying urban areas on December 29, 2022 and provided TIGER/Line shapefiles of the Census-defined urban area boundary for the respective urban areas in 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 101(a) of the Title 23 U.S. Code provides the State and responsible local officials the authority to cooperatively adjust urban area boundaries for purposes of applicability of Title 23 U.S. Code provisions; and

**WHEREAS**, the boundary adjustments to the 2020 Grand Island Census-defined urban area boundary was performed cooperatively between the Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) and GIAMPO; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed adjusted 2020 urban area boundary was reviewed and recommended for adoption by the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) of the MPO; and

**WHEREAS**, NDOT revised the proposed adjusted 2020 urban area boundary to include the future realignment of US-30 (Project Number: S-30-4(1046) and Control Number: 41704) since the TAC's review and recommendation and now the proposed adjusted 2020 urban area boundary requires official approval from the Policy Board of the MPO; and


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Policy Board of the Grand Island Area Metropolitan Planning Organization approves and adopts the proposed adjusted 2020 urban area boundary of the Grand Island Urban Area Map as identified in Exhibit A.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the MPO Program Manager is hereby authorized and directed to sign the signature block of the Grand Island Urban Area Map as identified in Exhibit A, which will be submitted to the Nebraska Department of Transportation.
