

GIAMPO RESOLUTION NO. 2024-7

Grand Island Area Metropolitan Planning Organization

A Resolution Approving the FY 2025 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

WHEREAS, the Grand Island Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (GIAMPO), is designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Grand Island Urbanized Area, by the Governor acting through the Nebraska Department of Transportation in cooperation with locally elected officials of the Grand Island Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, the MPO will document metropolitan transportation planning activities performed with funds provided under Title 23 U.S.C. and Title 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 in a Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) or simplified statement of work in accordance with the provisions of 23 CFR Parts 420 and 450, and must annually prepare a document that provides an overview of all proposed major work activities, funding levels, and funding sources; and

WHEREAS, the UPWP for Fiscal Year 2025, covering the period of July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025, was prepared, submitted to the Nebraska Department of Transportation, made available for public comment for a fifteen (15) day period, and was reviewed and recommended for adoption by the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) of the MPO, and now requires official approval from the Policy Board of the MPO; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Policy Board of the Grand Island Area Metropolitan Planning Organization approves and adopts the Unified Planning Work Program for Fiscal Year 2025.
