NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION CITY OF GRAND ISLAND, NEBRASKA

Public Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, that a special election has been called and will be held in the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, on Tuesday, August 13, 2024, at which there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of said City the following proposition:

BALLOT QUESTION

Shall the City of Grand Island be authorized to establish a good life district economic development program for any area within the City which is included in a good life district established pursuant to the Good Life Transformational Projects Act, and shall the City be authorized to appropriate the local sources of revenue collected within such good life district program area, which may include local option sales and use taxes and occupation taxes, established pursuant to and as permitted by the Good Life District Economic Development Act; provided that the City shall not appropriate property taxes to such program, and shall not appropriate local option sales and use tax or occupation tax sourced from outside the good life district to such program?

VOTE FOR or AGAINST

I vote FOR authorizing the City to establish a good life district economic development program and impose and appropriate local sources of revenue to such program.
I vote AGAINST authorizing the City to establish a good life district economic development program and impose and appropriate local sources of revenue to such program.

Electors voting in favor of the proposition shall blacken the oval opposite the words "I vote FOR" following such proposition, and electors voting against such proposition shall blacken the oval opposite the words "I vote AGAINST" following the proposition.

If a majority of the votes cast upon such question shall be in favor, then the governing body of the City of Grand Island shall be empowered to establish and implement a good life district economic development program and impose and appropriate the local sources of revenue upon the terms and conditions contained in the Good Life District Economic Development Act.

Ballots for early voting may be obtained from the Election Commissioner of Hall County, Nebraska in Grand Island, Nebraska.

This election will be an election by mail. All registered voters residing within the City of Grand Island will receive their ballot by mail and therefore no polling places will be open for voting. Ballots will be mailed by the Election Commissioner of Hall County between July 22, 2024, and August 3, 2024. Upon receipt of the official ballot, the registered voter shall mark it, seal the ballot in the identification envelope supplied with the ballot, sign the identification envelope, and comply with the instructions provided with the ballot.

Voter Registration Deadlines

The deadline to register to vote at an agency, online, with a deputy registrar, by mail or delivered by an agent is July 26, 2024. The deadline for in-person registration is August 2, 2024, by 6:00 p.m. at the Hall County Election Commissioner's Office located at 121 South Pine Street, Grand Island, Nebraska. Any voter who changes information on a current registration or registers to vote after the ballots have been mailed but before the in-person registration deadline of August 2, 2024, by 6:00 p.m., will be given a ballot at the time of registration or change.

Ballot Return Deadline

Voted ballots, sealed in the completed identification envelope and completed in accordance with the instructions provided with the ballot, must be delivered by mail, in person, or by an agent to the Hall County Election Commissioner's Office located at 121 South Pine Street, Grand Island, Nebraska, or placed in an official ballot drop box, and must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 13, 2024.
