Plus-City Dividend for Utility Ownership

All water services provided by the Grand Island Utilities Department will be subject to a City Dividend for Utility Ownership. The City Dividend for Utility Ownership will be set by resolution in the City of Grand Island Fee Schedule and calculated as a percentage of the total bill. The City Dividend for Utility Ownership will be identified as a separate line item on an electric bill and will be calculated as follows:

<u>City Dividend Water City Dividend-Rate</u> = Water <u>Usage</u> Bill Before Sales Tax * (1 - (1 / (1 - Lity Dividend)) Water City Dividend Rate

The City Dividend for Utility Ownership will be subject to applicable sales tax.

SECTION 2. Those portions of Section 35-30, as now existing, and any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be, and hereby are, repealed.

SECTION 3. The validity of any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication, in pamphlet form, on October 1, 2024. The ordinance shall be published in one issue of the Grand Island Independent as provided by law.
