2012 Summer Fun Skeet League

Signup at Heartland Public Shooting Park counter now!

Dates: Wednesdays 3 PM to 7 PM for 6 weeks beginning Wednesday, July 18th and running through Wednesday, August 22nd. Final awards and door prizes during steak feed on last night, Thursday, August 22nd after shoot-offs.

Cost: Signup (at HPSP counter) cost of \$15 per person. Participants also pay at HPSP counter for rounds shot each night at their regular HPSP rates and provide their own ammunition. Two rounds of Skeet (50 targets) per night. \$9.00 additional charge for guests at steak feed (please purchase at least one week before steak feed so we know how many steaks to buy).

Teams: Shooters sign up as individuals and optionally make up teams of 3 members. No additional charge to be on a team. Team members not required to shoot with each other. Shoot management will try to form teams from any shooters that don't pick their own teammates so that everyone is on a team and has a chance to win both team and individual awards.

Awards: Printed Winner certificates, Gift Certificates from GI Loan, and free rounds of skeet.

Each week a printed certificate to individual Champion, Runner-Up & 3rd and members of 1st place team. Each week's individual Champion also receives a \$15 Gift Certificate from GI Loan, Runner-Up 2 free rounds of skeet and 3rd 1 free round of skeet. Will often require shoot-offs (if you're handicapped score is 50 you will certainly be in the shoot-off). Shoot-offs will be miss and out regular skeet ASAP after 7:00 PM. Shoot-offs must be with same gauge used for the week or smallest gauge used for final shoot-offs at end of league. Score sheets must be turned in by 7:00 PM to be eligible for each evening's shoot-offs and awards.

At end of league, printed certificate to 1st, 2nd and 3rd individual and 1st, 2nd and 3rd team members based on 6 week totals. 3 free rounds of skeet to high individual, 2 to 2nd and 1 to 3rd. 1 free round of skeet to each member of 1st place team. Presented at steak feed on August 22nd after shoot-offs.

Handicap schedule: Heavily handicapped for fun! Handicapped for both gauge and score. Also "**Lucky Shooter**".

Gauge handicap is added before score handicap with 3 for 410, 2 for 28 ga., 1 for 20 ga. and none for 12 ga. Score handicap is 48 minus your running average including the current week score. So if your running average including gauge handicap is 10 and your score for the night is 10 your handicapped score would be 48. If you shoot 11 your handicapped score would be 49. And if you shoot a 12 or higher your handicapped score would be 50. Handicapped scores are capped at 50.

In addition there will be a "**Lucky Shooter**" handicap if there are not already at least 5 shooters present and qualified for each evening's shoot-off. In this case we will randomly select enough additional shooters from those present at shoot-off time so that there will be at least 5 shooters in the shoot-off each night. These "Lucky Shooters" will have their handicap score increased to the score that qualified for the evenings shoot-off.

Make ups: Can shoot up to two weeks in advance. Or can be made up anytime prior to the last day of the League. A shooter or team that shoots in advance may still receive an award but a shooter or team that makes up afterwards will not be eligible for awards from the previous week(s). In case a shoot-off is required (and it almost always will be) absent shooters forfeit.

Youth: Participants under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
