Sealed bids will be **received at the office of the City Clerk**, 100 E. First Street., Grand Island, NE 68801 or P.O. Box 1968, Grand Island, Nebraska 68802 until **2:15 p.m., (Local Time), Thursday, March 28, 2013,** for furnishing **Foaming Root Control Chemical,** for the City of Grand Island. Bids will be publicly opened at this time in the Conference Room #1 located on 1st floor of City Hall. Bids received after specified time will be returned unopened to sender.

Bids shall be submitted on forms which will be furnished by the City. **Please return one original and one copy of each bid sheet.**

The successful bidder will be required to comply with fair labor standards as required by Nebraska R.R.S. 73-102 and comply with Nebraska R.R.S. 48-657 pertaining to contributions to the Unemployment Compensation Fund of the State of Nebraska.

Successful bidder shall comply with the City's insurance requirements. Successful bidder shall maintain a Drug Free Workplace Policy.

Bids will be evaluated by the Purchaser based on price, quality, specification, economy and efficiency of operation, experience and reputation of bidder, ability, capacity, and skill of the bidder to furnish chemical required and adaptability of the particular items to the specific use intended.

The Purchaser reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive irregularities therein and to accept whichever bid that may be in the best interest of the City, at its sole discretion. The Purchaser also reserves the right to reject any section(s) of a selected bid that may be in the best interest of the City, at its sole discretion.

No bidder may withdraw their bid for a period of sixty (60) days after date of opening bids.

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR Foaming Root Control Chemical

CITY OF GRAND ISLAND

Sealed bids will received at the office of the City Clerk, 100 East First Street, P.O. Box 1968, Grand Island, Nebraska, 68802 until 2:15 p.m., (Local Time), Thursday, March 28, 2013, for furnishing Foaming Root Control Chemical as specified in these bidding Documents, FOB Grand Island, Nebraska.

Exceptions to Specifications

Any bidder who has exceptions to any specifications and requirements listed in the bidding documents must so state in the space provided below. It is the bidder's responsibility to clearly outline any exceptions. Failure by bidder to outline exceptions will require the successful bidder to comply with the specifications.

Attached are detailed minimum specifications. The following general specifications also apply to this Bid.

Manuals

Supply manuals as required in minimum specifications.

Warranty

See detailed specifications for warranty requirements. Bidder should include warranty details with their bid; failure to comply may be cause for rejection of bid.

Description Literature

The bidder shall attach hereto, and it shall be made part of this Bid, regularly printed literature as published by the factory which sets out and fully describes the chemical to be furnished in the Bid. This literature or other supplemental information shall clearly indicate compliance with each and every item of these specifications. Failure to indicate compliance may be cause for rejection of Bid.

OSHA & ANSI Requirements

In addition to other specified requirements, the chemical shall meet all current Occupational Safety and Health Administration and American National Standards Institute requirement specifications.

Delivery

Chemical is to be delivered from assembly point to Grand Island, Nebraska, by Commercial freight, rail or truck.

Delivery Date

Each Bidder shall state in said Bid a realistic delivery date for this chemical. Award winning Bidder must deliver within quoted delivery time.

Payment

Prior to approving the invoice for payment, the City reserves the right to thoroughly inspect chemical to confirm compliance with specifications. Any chemical that does not meet the City's requirements will be returned at vendor's expense for correction. Title, manufacturer's use tax form and manuals must be received prior to approval of invoice.

The invoice will be paid at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting occurring after the approval of the invoice; the City Council typically meets the second and fourth Tuesday of each month. Invoices must be received well in advance of Council date to allow time for evaluation and processing. The furnished chemical must be new, the latest make or model, unless otherwise specified. The City of Grand Island Public Works Wastewater Division is tax exempt.

Fair Employment Practices

Each Bidder agrees that they will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment based on age, race, color, religious creed, ancestry, handicap, sex or political affiliation.

Data Privacy

Bidder agrees to abide by all applicable Local, State and Federal laws and regulations concerning the handling and disclosure of private and confidential information concerning individuals and corporations as to inventions, patents, and patent rights. The Bidder agrees to hold the City harmless from any claims resulting from Bidder's unlawful disclosure or use of private or confidential information.

Independent Price Determination

By signing and submitting this Bid, the Bidder certifies that: the prices in the Bid have been arrived at independently, without consultation, communication or agreement, for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices with any other Bidder or with any competitor.

Clarification of Specification Documents

Vendors shall promptly notify the Purchasing Agent of any ambiguity, inconsistency, or error which they may discover upon examination of the specifications. Interpretations, corrections and changes made to the specifications will be made by written addenda. Oral interpretations or changes to the specification made in any other manner will not be binding on the City and Bidders shall not rely upon such interpretations or changes. Demonstration/Samples

If requested, the Bidder shall, at Bidder's expense, demonstrate and/or furnish samples of the exact items(s) proposed within seven (7) calendar days from receipt of such request from the City.

Bid Evaluation and Award

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after Bid date. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive technicalities and to accept the bid considered by the Purchaser to be in the City's best interest. Bids will be evaluated based on conformity to specifications, price, formulation and packaging of product and experience of the manufacturer.

Gratuities and Kickbacks

City Code states that it is unethical for any person to offer, give or agree to give any City employee or former employee, or for any City employee or former City employee to solicit, demand, accept, or agree to accept from another person, a gratuity or an offer of employment in connection with any decision, approval, disapproval, recommendation, or preparation of any specification or procurement standard, rendering of advice, investigation, auditing, or in any other advisory capacity in any proceeding or application, request for ruling, determination, claim or controversy, or other particular matter, pertaining to any program requirement or a contract or subcontract, or to any solicitation or proposal therefore. It shall be unethical for any payment, gratuity, or offer of employment to be made by or on the behalf of a subcontractor under a contract to the prime contractor or higher tier subcontractor or any person associated therewith, as an inducement for the award of a subcontractor order.

Budget years

The City of Grand Island, Nebraska operates on a fiscal year beginning October 1st and ending on the following September 30th. It is understood and agreed that any portion of this agreement which will be performed in a future fiscal year is contingent upon the City Council adopting budget statements and appropriations sufficient to fund such performance.

MINIMUM BID SPECIFICATIONS

FOAMING ROOT CONTROL CHEMICAL

The chemical must be compatible to work with the Foaming equipment that the City already has. The current foaming machine is a <u>Jet Set Commander Vaporooter Rootfoamer</u>.

The City will consider any chemical that meets or exceeds required minimum specifications as stated herein or any approved equal chemical. The City of Grand Island reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive any technicalities.

Note: Chemical must be produced in the current year.

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 The purpose of this document is to specify a product to control tree roots in sanitary sewers.
 - Only products designed to be applied by foam generating equipment injecting compressed air into a surfactant to generate a small dense bubble containing the combination of Metam sodium and Dichlobenil will be considered.
 - Chemicals designed to be applied by soaking, spraying, dusting, pouring down the manholes, or other similar non-mechanical methods of application will not be considered.
- 1.2 The active ingredients in the chemical root control agent shall be Metam Sodium and Dichlobenil.
 - Only products that contain both of these active ingredients specifically labeled for use in sanitary sewers to control tree roots will be considered.

2. COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAWS

- 2.1 In accordance with federal and state law, only products which are currently registered with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and with the Nebraska Department of Agriculture will be considered.
- 2.2 Bidders must be licensed as pesticide dealers with Nebraska Department of Agriculture (DOA) before filling any orders placed for materials by the City, as required by law.
- 2.3 All packing, and shipping procedures must comply with federal and state Department of Transportation (DOT) laws and regulations.

3. TYPE AND COMPOSITION OF THE CHEMICAL ROOT CONTROL AGENT

- 3.1 The product shall be composed of these components:
 - Metam Sodium: The Metam Sodium shall be packaged within a water soluble foaming agent containing a minimum of 30.0% AI (active ingredient) by weight.

- <u>Dichlobenil:</u> The Dichiobenil shall be formulated as minimum 50W wettable clay powder.
- A five (5) gallon unit of chemical root control product must contain 30 ounces of 50W Dichlobenil packaged in a water soluble packing material to minimize worker exposure.
- 3.2 <u>Foaming Agent:</u> The foaming agent, when mixed as a 1% aqueous solution and applied through standard foam application equipment, shall produce a small bubble, dense foam capable of sustaining its shape and remaining on treated roots for a period of one (1) hour.

4. PACKAGING

- 4.1 Containers must meet all DOT and OSHA requirements for the product supplied.
- 4.2 All pesticide containers shall be palletized and plastic wrapped.

5. EQUIPMENT COMPATIBILTY

5.1 Bidders must warrant that the materials bid herein are compatible for use with the City's Jet Set Commander Vaporooter Rootfoamer Machine, the current chemical root control equipment used.

6. WARRANTY

- 6.1 The Bidder shall warranty the chemical products as follows:
 - The Bidder <u>warranty's the product's shelf life for two (2) years</u> from the date of delivery.
 - Any chemical product that is determined by the City to be defective in foam quality and/or chemical composition, within this two (2) year period, will be returned to the Bidder at Bidder's expense, for a full refund.

7. REQUIRMENTS CONTRACT

- 7.1 The City is not obligated to any minimum or maximum quantities under the contract.
- 7.2 Estimated purchases for FY2012/2013 not to exceed \$25,000.00.
- 7.3 The City intends to issue a purchase order or orders to Bidder, to whom the contract is awarded for chemical on an as-needed basis, although nothing in this document or elsewhere in the contract documents shall be construed as obligating the City to do so.
- 7.4 Upon receipt of a purchase order, the Bidder will deliver all chemical product specified by the purchase order to the City, within thirty (30) calendar days.

7.5 The City reserves the right to inspect and test all chemical products as they delivered, and to reject any chemical product that in the opinion of the City is unsatisfactory.

8. CONDITIONS OF SALE

- 8.1 The City will employ trained and experienced applicators to handle and use pesticides.
- 8.2 The City will comply with all State and Federal laws governing the use of pesticides, and obtain all necessary licenses and permits required to apply the chemical product specified herein.
- 8.3 The product specified herein is for the use of the City, and is intended strictly for use by appropriate City personnel on the City's sanitary sewer systems.

9. BASIS FOR AWARD

- 9.1 Proposals will be evaluated based on several factors, including:
 - Price quoted by the Bidder
 - Conformity to specifications
 - Formulation and packaging of product
 - Experience of the manufacturer

10. SUBMITTAL

- 10.1 The following must be submitted with this bid:
 - Specimen labels (Dichlobenil, Metam Sodium)
 - Description of product packaging, including brochures
 - Material Safety Data Sheet
 - Copy of the product registration with the State of Nebraska Department of Agriculture
 - Copy of Bidders state pesticide dealer's license
- 10.2 Failure to include the above will be judged by the City as unresponsive, and will disqualify the bid.
