Warranty	The equipment shall carry the standard warranty; bidder should include warranty details with the bid; failure to comply may cause bid rejection.
Descriptive Literature	The bidder shall attach hereto, and it shall be made part of this bid, regularly printed literature as published by the factory which sets out and fully describes the equipment to be furnished in the bid. OSHA & ANSI Requirements

In addition to other specified requirements, the equipment shall meet all current Occupational Safety and Health Administration and American National Standards Institute requirement specifications.

All 72" mowing equipment will have ROPS protection provided with cab on and when cab is removed from mower in summer months, a folding ROPS protection is required.

Delivery

Equipment is to be delivered from manufacturing point to Grand Island, Nebraska, by commercial freight, rail or truck.

Delivery Date

Each bidder shall state in his/her bid a realistic delivery date for this equipment. Award winning bidder must deliver within quoted delivery time.

Payment

The equipment must be new, the latest make or model, unless otherwise specified. Prior to approving the invoice for payment, the City reserves the right to thoroughly inspect and test the equipment to confirm compliance with specifications. Any equipment which does not meet the City's requirements will be returned at vendor's expense for correction. Any specified data, diagrams and manuals must be received prior to approval of invoice. The invoice will be paid after approval at the next regularly scheduled Council meeting occurring after departmental approval of invoice; the City Council typically meets the second and fourth Tuesday of each month. Invoices must be received well in advance of Council date to allow evaluation and processing time.

Trade-In

Successful bidder will include in said bid a trade-in value and accept as trade-in one (1) 1993 Smitco Ballfield Groomer, 16 HP Kohler Engine, Model #13-450, front blade, center scarifier and rear rake blades. The bidder agrees to hold the City harmless from any claims resulting from the bidder's unlawful disclosure or use of private or confidential information.

Independent Price Determination - By signing and submitting bid, the bidder certifies that: the prices in the bid have been arrived at independently, without consultation, communication or agreement, for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices with any other bidder or with any competitor.

Clarification of Specification Documents - Vendors shall promptly notify the Purchasing Agent of any ambiguity, inconsistency or error which they may discover upon examination of the specifications. Interpretations, corrections and changes made to the specifications will be made by written addenda. Oral interpretations or changes to the specifications made in any other manner will not be binding on the City; and bidders shall not rely upon such interpretations or changes.

Demonstration/Samples - If requested, the bidders shall, at bidder's expense, demonstrate and/or furnish samples of the exact item(s) proposed within seven (7) calendar days from receipt of such request from the City.

Bid Evaluation and Award - No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) days after bid due date. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive technicalities and to accept the bid considered by the Purchaser to be in the City's best interest. The bid will be evaluated based on price, demonstration (if requested) quality, warranty, adherence to specifications, delivery, and adaptability of the particular equipment for the specific use intended.

Gratuities and Kickbacks - Gratuities. It shall be unethical for any person to offer, give, or agree to give any City employee or former City employee, or for any City employee or former City employee to solicit, demand, accept, or agree to accept from another person, a gratuity or an offer of employment in connection with any decision, approval, disapproval, recommendation, or preparation of any part of a program requirement or a purchase request, influencing the content of any specification or procurement standard, rendering of advice, investigation, auditing, or in any other advisory capacity in any proceeding or application, request for ruling, determination, claim or controversy, or other particular matter, pertaining to any program requirement or a contract or subcontract, or to any solicitation or proposal therefor. Kickbacks. Minimum Bid Specifications

The units described shall be new, 2013 or 2014 Models, and manufacture's latest design and production, complete, including all standard equipment and any optional equipment as deemed necessary by the City of Grand Island. Use of brand names is for the purpose of describing the standard of quality, performance and characteristics described and is not intended to limit or restrict competition. The units shall be complete with all parts and components not specifically mentioned in this specification but which are required to provide a complete unit. The units must arrive serviced and ready for work. The City will consider any unit that meets required minimum specifications as stated herein. Depending on individual prices, purchases may be made from more than one (1) vendor. The City of Grand Island reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive any technicalities, at its sole discretion.

Item #1

<u>REQUIRED MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS FOR:</u> One (1) New Commercial 120" Cut Rotary Turf Mower

1. ENGINE:

• 55 net HP minimum and torque adequate for cutting long grass in all types of weather and terrain. 4 cylinder diesel, liquid cooled, radiator should be heavy duty construction, situated so it does not attract debris and easily cleanable in the field, pressure lubrication system with spin off oil filter, Donaldson Heavy Duty air cleaner with 18 gallon minimum fuel capacity and replaceable fuel filter. The mowing unit should not produce more than 94 dB(A) of noise with decks engaged.

2. TRANSMISSION:

• Variable speed hydrostatic traction drive with hydrostatic closed loop system, foot operated traction pedal and transmission oil cooler with filter. Drive full time 4-wheel hydrostatic drive, 2-wheel for transport, front and rear wheel motors.

3. SPEED:

• Forward transport speed minimum 14 mph.

4. <u>TIRES</u>:

• Tubeless turf tread on demountable rims with large surface area to provide good traction in slippery conditions while not scuffing the turf. A minimum 6-ply tire is required on the traction unit.

5. STEERING:

• Automotive type full power rear wheel steering with maximum turning in either direction. Steering wheel tilt to desired operator position.

6. SEAT:

High back suspension seat with armrests and forward-backward adjustments.

7. ELECTRICAL:

Large capacity automotive type 12 volt system with keyed on-off switch, heavy duty battery and fuses/circuit breaker protection, gauges to include an hour meter, fuel gauge, temperature gauge, oil pressure, glow plug and ammeter. Road light kit mounted on mowing unit at time of delivery to include front and rear four-way flashers and front lights.

8. BRAKES:

• Individual wheel and parking brakes on front traction wheels. Dynamic braking obtained by hydrostatic traction drive.

9. <u>MANEUVERABILITY</u>:

• Very tight turning circle while rear tires stay within the cut swath and does not swing out to hit obstacles.

10. <u>DECK</u>: Outfront Cutting Deck Preferred

• Hydraulic lift mowing units with drive to be hydraulic. Units can be run using a combination of the 3 decks. Units to be rear discharge. Cutting height easily adjustable from 1 – 5 inches in ½ inch increments. Cutting width at least 120 inches. Ground contour following and anti-scalping should be at least as good as 72" trim mowers. Bi-directional, impact absorption device on each wing deck.

11. CLEARANCE:

• Minimum of 6 inches. Ground clearance to allow for climbing most obstacles incurred in mowing parks and roadside areas or during transport.

12. FRAME:

• The frame should be welded steel construction with enough rigidity and strength to provide durability throughout the life of the product and with all types of cutting units and attachments.

13. ROPS:

• ROPS required on unit.

Item #2

REQUIRED MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS FOR:

One (1) New Commercial 72" Cut Rotary Turf Mower with Hard Cab, Six (6) Foot Rear Discharge Deck and Snow Blower

1. ENGINE

• 25 HP minimum, 3 cylinder diesel, liquid cooled, pressure lubrication system with spin off filter, Donaldson heavy duty air cleaner or equal, with 10 gal. minimum fuel capacity.

DRIVE TRAIN

• Variable speed hydrostatic drive with foot operated traction pedal and transmission oil cooler with filter, 4-wheel drive, 2-wheel for transport.

SPEED

• Transport Speed minimum 10 MPH.

4. TIRES

• 2 front and 2 rear tubeless minimum 4-ply turf tread.

5. <u>STEERING</u>

• Hydraulic power steering with automotive type steering wheel and rear wheel steering.

6. SEAT

High back suspension seat with armrests and forward-backward adjustments.

7. ELECTRICAL

• 12-volt system with keyed on-off switch, gauges to include – coolant temperature, oil pressure warning light, hour meter, glow plug indicator, ammeter.

8. <u>IMPLEMENT LIFT AND DRIVE</u>

Hydraulic lift, drive to be hydraulic or PTO shaft driven.

9. DECK

• Minimum 7 gauge steel, reinforced at stress points, cutting heights adjustable approximately from minimum 1" to maximum 5" range adjustable in maximum of 1/2" increments, caster wheels to be pneumatic wheel and tire assembly, 72" rear discharge deck with mulching mower blades.

10. DELIVERY

Mower will be delivered with cab installed and mower deck attached to unit.

• Two stage, minimum 47" maximun 48" width, hydraulic or electric chute rotation, adjustable skid shoes, quick hitch mounting with applicable mounting kits, counter weights as needed. Capable of handling wet heavy snow.

ROPS mower cab, steel constructed with 360° full view safety glass, door entry from either side, side and rear windows open for ventilation, premium quality upholstered interior and rubber floor mat to provide a quiet environment; with heater-defroster fan, front head lights, 4-way flashers, front wiper, interior mirror.
